No, they go on an international database which, to put it simply, catalogues every one of the millions of parts for all the world's aircraft, and tells them where that part is located.

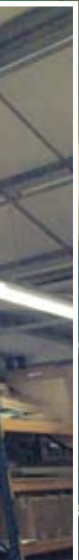
